FROM THE SIDELINES



When I was thinking about what to write about for this edition of the Herald, Amy suggested I write an article about how hockey used to be when I started up in 1979. So here goes:

Back in 1979 we played all our matches on grass with the club sharing a clubhouse with a cricket club – this was common for many clubs back in the day.

In the winter most weeks we needed to phone the skipper to check if the match was on or not due to rain and waterlogged pitches.

Goals were different then, still the same size but had to be built by the home team prior to the match. There was a hut next to the club house from where we had to carry posts, cross bar, back boards, guy-ropes, nets and a bag of nuts and bolts, build the goals, and then take them down at the end of the game.

Half time? No Lucozade, water or energy drinks. Everyone sucked on a quarter of an orange and it was part of the home duties to team to supply the half time oranges, all cut up of course. There was such a thing as a "hand-stop" for a penalty corner as opposed to the stick stop nowadays. This meant a very quick movement away from the ball after it had been stopped, if not the chances of a broken finger were high as the striker took the shot.

Although this did not happen at Harrow, I once played for a club that had selection by letter, where selection for the next two weeks was done on a Monday and the teams printed out on a roller printer, folded up and sent out by mail. No emails or text messages back then!

And some words on the London League which was the league Hampstead played in (there was no "and Westminster" then) when I was with them back in the early 1980's, the lovely pic of me was taken in the playoff finals in 1982!

1/ No promotion or relegation for the 26 invited teams. The league was a closed shop, and there were many good clubs who could not join. There were leagues for 1st XI, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th teams all run on the same basis. 2/ It wasn't really London as it contained St Albans and both Oxford and Cambridge Universities, but once you were in you were in.

3/ Not everyone played everyone else. Hampstead were one of only a handful of teams that had a scheduled fixture against all the other teams.

4/ If a game was postponed, which happened quite a bit as most games were still played on grass, they were rarely re-scheduled.

5/ The league positions were decided on "percentage of points won". So – at the end of the season a team could have played 17 matches and were ranked against another who had played 19. This led to some interesting postponements and team selections so teams could protect their percentage and I recall a particularly strange incident against another club where a game was tactically off which helped secure a higher league position.

I know the new England Hockey League and structure could be improved but could you imagine a league run on this basis now!
